2026 Center Cougar Boosters Scholarship Award

The Center High School Booster Club (Center Cougar Boosters) will award one \$500.00 and two \$250 scholarships to Center High School graduating seniors whose family member is a current Cougar Booster Club Member as of 3/1/26 or has volunteered (student) with Center Cougar Boosters during the 25/26 school year (including summer of 2025). The scholarships are being provided as assistance to students for the continuance of their education beyond high school.

Scholarship recipients will be selected in an unbiased manner through the Booster Club Scholarship Committee. The committee will select the three applicants who most closely meet the Booster Club Scholarship criteria and decide on the winners. Scholarships will be awarded based on the applicants' school involvement, community involvement, citizenship, experiences and goals.

It is important that applicants read the scholarship policy. The policy explains the rules governing the application process and the payment of the scholarship by the booster club.

The announcement of the awards will be made by the school once senior activities dates have been announced by Center High School. Funds will be presented to the award winners upon their presentation of verification of enrollment to a licensed and/or accredited university, college, community college, trade or vocational school or apprenticeship program by the Booster Club Treasurer.

Center Cougar Boosters Scholarship Policy

PURPOSE: The Center High School Booster Club intends to annually award scholarships to Center High School graduating seniors. The purpose of the program is to recognize and reward the achievements of these young people and to support them in their future educational endeavors.

DEFINITION OF SCHOLARSHIP: Applications will be accepted from students who plan to enter a university, college, community college, trade school, vocational school or apprenticeship program to continue their education beyond high school.

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM QUALIFICATION: All universities, colleges, community colleges, trade schools, vocational schools or apprenticeship programs shall be licensed and/or accredited. The Scholarship Committee has the authority and responsibility to confirm each applicant's program designation.

UNALLOCATED FUNDS: Any unallocated scholarship funds will be retained in the Booster Club general account. Funds must be requested and paid by 3pm September 11, 2026.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- The applicant must be a graduating senior from Center High School whose family member is a current Cougar Booster Club Member or student Booster volunteer.
- The applicant must submit a COMPLETE application. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- The decisions of the Scholarship Committee shall be final.
- The applicant must have a 2.5 GPA or higher.
- All applications must be complete and turned in on time. Applicants

whose packet is incomplete will not be considered.

RECEIPT OF FUNDS: Prior to the release of funds, the recipient must show proof of enrollment in a qualified educational program. Funds are to be requested through the Booster Club Treasurer. A letter of instruction will accompany the certificate of award presented at such time that winners are awarded.
